## **2. DECLERATIONS OF INTEREST**

- 2.1. JM declared an interest in the Fablab Project.

## **3. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING**

- 3.1. Minutes of the meeting held on the 12<sup>th</sup> September 2023 agreed as a true record.
- 3.2. No matters arising.

## **4. LONG TERM PLAN FOR TOWNS – HELEN JACKSON**

- 4.1. HJ provided an update on the Long Term Plan for Towns.
- 4.2. DK stressed the importance of a refresh of the board and how many new members the board wish to recruit. JG stated that the existing membership should be looked at.
- 4.3. RDR questioned the current skills of the board and what the board should be looking for in new members. AR stated that an audit of the board can be carried out by North Yorkshire Council.
- 4.4. RGu questioned if the extent of the powers given by this funding would stretch to vacant hotels. HJ stated that it is uncertain at this time due to a lack of guidance.

## **5. FABLAB – ALEX RICHARDS/DAN FISHER**

- 5.1. AR/ DF provided an overview of the Fablab project and the options for the project as per the paper circulated.
- 5.2. DK questioned how fast the project can move ahead. DF went through the options for the project and the potential dates of when the project could be completed by. AR stated that this aspect for the project is just for the facility, an operator would still be needed.
- 5.3. Board members discussed the pros and cons of the options presented to the board. The use of the unit on Vernon Road was seen as preferable.
- 5.4. DK asked for the board to show favour for the use of Vernon Road as the location to take the Fablab forward. JM and LP abstained from the vote, a majority vote of the board saw to recommend Vernon Road as the location for the Fablab.

## **6. WEST PIER CONSULTATION – HELEN JACKSON**

- 6.1. HJ provided an update on the consultation carried out for the Scarborough West Pier project.

- 6.2. DB stated that he had met with the harbour users and they had several concerns including: the lack of boat lift, crab pot storage and overtopping. DB also confirmed he passed on drawings to RF given to him by the harbour users.
- 6.3. SB commented on the national sailing competition off Scarborough and concerns that facilities aren't up to scratch.

## **7. TOWNS FUND PROGRAMME UPDATE – HELEN JACKSON**

- 7.1. HJ provided a verbal update on the Scarborough Town Deal programme.
- 7.2. RGo stated that he may be able to help with the delays in the Station Gateway Project.
